Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you all had a relatively restful half term without any remote learning to worry about!

You will most likely have heard the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday in which he stated that all primary pupils can return to school on Monday, 8th March. We are obviously delighted that all of our pupils are now able to return, but we must also ensure that we mitigate any possibilities of the spread of COVID.

Over the next few days, we will be reviewing our risk assessment, alongside our plans for lunches, entrance to school etc. The organisation for the return of pupils between September and December, in our view, worked well, so apart from some tweaks, we would envisage that this system will be the one we return to in two week's time. This will include the full reopening of wraparound services.

All information will be shared with you in ample time so that you are aware of when the children start and so on. In the meantime, we will continue to provide on site education for those pupils who are eligible, as well as remote learning for those working at home.
