A Roman ship

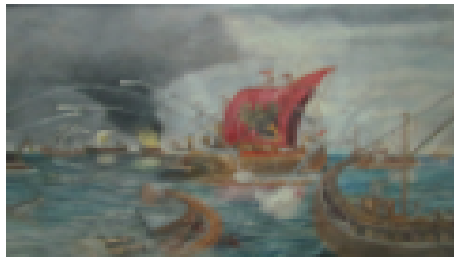
In the 300s the tallest ship was 100m and could fit more than 1000 people and had a ginormous sail that helped the boat drive its way to their island/war.
