Dear families,

We are approaching the end of the summer term and unfortunately COVID restrictions are still in place, which means that many planned events have had to change.

### **Sport's Day 2021**

Following up on the message that we cannot have parents at the sport's day, school have had a significant amount of backlash around this decision. We had hoped that we could invite you onto the school field to see at least one event. When the government made the decision to delay the wider reopening of events and lift restrictions, we looked very carefully at the guidelines and have followed protocols. We also sought advice from Health and Safety and our Risk Assessments have been updated.

The guidance clearly states that the legal gathering limits where spectators can gather outside in separate groups is up to 30. Most of our classes are larger than 30, so even with one adult per child, we would be failing to comply with guidelines. We will take as many photos as we can to share with you.

I understand that this is disappointing for many of you, particularly if this is your child's last year at primary school, but we have followed the guidelines to stay safe.

As Euro 2020 is taking place, we can all see the groups of supporters and crowds. They have a different set of guidelines to follow, so we cannot be compared to those. Our priority is protecting the staff and pupils. I have also heard comments that parents are allowed to gather on the yard when collecting children and it is the same. I would like to remind you that you must still socially distance while collecting your children. Staggered leaving times and a one-way system is still in place to support this.

### **Communication**

We value ClassDojo and the flexibility that it offers us in terms of school to home communication. To receive all of the messages, please ensure that your notifications are turned on.

I would like to remind you to be respectful to staff on ClassDojo and where possible to only send messages during working hours. Please do not expect that staff will message you back on an evening or a weekend. Teachers often receive messages about enquiries that they can't answer, as they are in reference to decisions that the senior leadership team have made. I know that it is very easy to send a quick ClassDojo message, but if it is related to a whole school decision then please direct any messages through the office email [soffice@stmarysjarrow.co.uk](mailto:soffice@stmarysjarrow.co.uk) and they can be dealt with by the leadership team.

### **Staffing**

We are finalising our staffing arrangements for next year and we will inform you about your child's teacher for next academic year as soon as the final decisions are made.

Our three teaching students, Mr. Gray, year 5, Miss Buzzeo, year 2, and Mrs. Miller, year 1 are completing their time at St. Mary's. They have all been at the school since the start of the academic year and have progressed really well. Mr. Gray and Mrs. Miller leave on Friday and Miss Buzzeo leaves next Wednesday. They have all said that they will volunteer some time in the next few weeks so that they can still support the children, so you may still see them around. They are all dedicated and will be wonderful teachers.



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### NSPCC

In our PSHE lesson on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2021, we will be discussing the NSPCC's Underwear Rule. This is designed to teach pupils how to stay safe from sexual abuse, without giving explicit information or telling scary stories or even using the term "sexual abuse."

In the lesson, children will learn about the 'PANTS' acrostic, which stands for:

- Privates are private
- Always remember your body belongs to you
- No means no
- Talk about secrets that upset you
- Speak up, someone can help

The lesson will be delivered in a way that's fully age-appropriate.

### Transition

We have unfortunately had to cancel our up-coming reception meeting on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> June, due to COVID guidelines. The children will be transitioned through nursery, and those not in our nursery have been invited into school. A pack with information will be sent out to you. If your nursery child is attending a different school then they will be in touch directly with you.

Reception children are transitioning to the main the school. They are being taught in the main school on a Monday pm and are going to have their lunch on a Thursday in the dining hall. This has an impact on the bubbles that we have in the hall. To accommodate this, we will be providing upper key stage classes with a packed lunch instead of a hot dinner on alternative Thursdays for the next few weeks. If the weather is nice they will be able to eat outside.

### Summer holiday provision

We are definitely running provision for the first two weeks of the holidays. Week one is going to be run by Grassroots and the second week will be led by school staff. I am trying to identify if we have secured funding for the two weeks, but it is unfortunately taking a long time. The timing will fit in with the normal school day and wraparound will not be provided.

To secure a place on either club please pay a £5 deposit on parent pay. This will need to be paid for both clubs if you want to secure a place. The maximum cost is £40 each week. Once we know about the funding then we will adjust payments depending on what we receive. The clubs will go on ParentPay tomorrow.
