### Systems in school

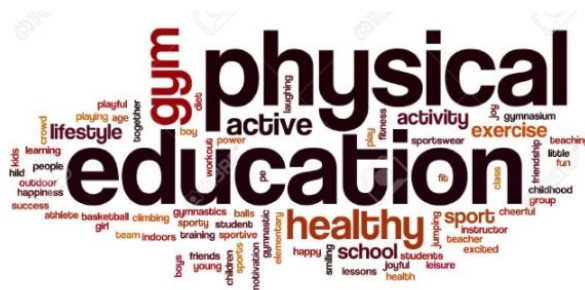

### Class DoJo

If you are not signed up to ClassDojo, then please download the APP and ask the class teacher to give you access.

### Reception

The new starters have settled so well into school; we are so pleased with them all and we welcome them to our family. The children will be paired up with a year 6 buddy to support them and they will be introduced to the school in a welcome assembly and mass. Dates will follow.

### Uniform

Our uniform requirements are very simple as items can easily be purchased at many shops. Please support us in ensuring that your child wears the correct uniform.

Our school uniform policy can be found on the school website. It consists of

- Black school shoes- not trainers.
- Grey trousers / shorts/ skirt/ dress
- Light blue polo t-shirt
- Navy school jumper which is available from Emblematic and Initial Images.

### Additional support

As a school, we support many children with long and short-term difficulties. We are hosting a coffee morning on the first Thursday of every month for families of children who have been identified as having a special education need or disability or are receiving additional support. Individual families have been sent information, but if you think it would be helpful to you then please come along. There is a poster with additional information on in the main yard in school noticeboard.

### Homework

This week and next will see the children come home with their half-termly spelling sheet and curriculum newsletter. Please help your children learn the spellings in advance of their test. All children have been given a reading book this week; in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 your child will have a set reading day. KS2 will be heard to read across the week. All children need to bring their book to school daily. We would like you to encourage your child to read at home.

Homework is currently weekly reading and spellings. Lexia and TimesTables Rock Stars or Numbots is also to be completed at home; the teachers monitor this so please complete sessions at home. Passwords remain the same as last year and will be sent out via Class DoJo. Classes will also receive homework that supports them in class, this will vary depending on the individual needs of the children. The class teachers will inform you of any homework that is sent or due via Class DoJo.
