


## YEAR SIX NEWSLETTER – SPRING A

In maths, we will be developing our understanding of shapes and statistics. We will also be introducing algebra! Once again, quick recall of times table facts will be essential!

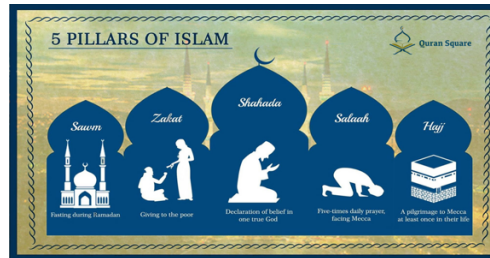

$$X = \frac{-b \pm \sqrt{b^2 - 4ac}}{2a}$$

In French, pupils will continue to develop their vocabulary about clothing, creating more advanced sentences to express opinions.



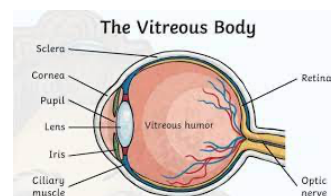
Our current RE topic is all about the Bible, who wrote it and what it can teach Christians.
