Dear families,

This half term we have been continuing to learn about animals as part of our 'Come outside' topic and are focusing in particular on minibeasts and farm animals. We have enjoyed looking for minibeasts in the outdoor environment, reading key stories such as 'What the ladybird heard' and 'The very hungry caterpillar', making a wormery, drawing creatures and looking carefully at their body parts to learn new vocabulary. Emma brought her exotic animals into Nursery in February for us to explore and this was a very successful day. We had the opportunity to handle snakes, snails, frogs, owls, lizards and stick insects and learn more about what these animals eat and the types of habitats they live in. On Monday 20<sup>th</sup> March we are expecting a delivery of duck eggs, which we will watch hatch and then enjoy handling the ducklings, feeding them and helping to look after them in the coming weeks. We are reading key stories about farm animals, such as 'Farmer duck' and 'Rosie's walk', will draw story maps, play with farm animals and develop our representation and story telling skills.

As Spring unfolds we will also enjoy activities linked to seasonal changes in our environment and the coming celebration of Easter. We would like to invite parents into Nursery to help with our allotment, which is just coming back to life.
