In Maths, we will be developing our understanding of statistics by interpreting pie charts. We will also look at problems involving ratio and proportion. There will be lots of revision on all aspects of maths covered so far.

P.E is every Wednesday and Friday. Children will be refining their skills in Cricket and Tennis this half term. Please ensure that children wear the correct P.E kit on these days.

In French, the children will continue to use a range of speaking, listening, reading and writing skills to discuss their town and the places that they enjoy visiting in their home town.

In Music, we will be preparing for our end of year production of 'Treasure Island.' In computing, pupils will be developing their understanding of programming in games such as Scratch.

Our current R.E topic is witness. We will explore how Christians believe that the spirit of God is active in each person and in a special way in the community of believers which is the Church. The Feast of Pentecost is the celebration both of the gift of God's Holy Spirit and the trust God places in people to be witnesses in the world.



In History, we will be studying crime and punishment through time. By the end of the unit, pupils will understand what is meant by the terms 'crime' and 'punishment' and how societies' views have changed over time. They will recognise similarities and differences between what is considered a crime and identify how the level and severity of punishment has changed over time.

We will be continuing to develop our SPaG and reading skills. We will look at test techniques for SATs.

We will continue to read our class text 'Holes' as well as a range of other texts based on these genres.

This half term's science topic is all about living things and how they are categorised.

In Personal Development, children will become increasingly familiar with British Values and how these may impact on their lives.

In Art, we will explore sculpture using foil. We will also explore the human form inspired by Henry Moore and Alberto Giacometti.
