Kit yarn

100m black (MC)

70m white (CC1)

50m blue (CC2)

30m Coral (CC3)

20m yellow (CC4)

### About the yarn

4-ply; 270m per 89g;

100% polyester

### Tension

28 sts x 36 rows =

10cm measured over

St st

### Needles used

3.25mm straight

### Other supplies

toy filling

pair of safety eyes,

10mm

crochet hook to add

scarf tassels

3cm pompom maker or

cardboard circles

### Sizing

33cm tall

All pieces are worked flat on straight knitting needles, but most could be converted to knitting in the round if you prefer.

## Start knitting...

### Body

#### Starting at the base

With CC1, cast on 9 sts.

**Row 1 & foll WS rows:** Knit.

**Row 2:** K1, [kfb] 8 times.  
17 sts

**Row 4:** K1, [kfb, k1] 8 times. 25 sts

**Row 6:** K1, [kfb, k2] 8 times. 33 sts

**Row 8:** K1, [kfb, k3] 8 times. 41 sts

**Rows 9-43:** Knit.

**Row 44:** K1, [k2tog, k3] 8 times. 33 sts

**Row 46:** Knit.

**Row 48:** K1, [k2tog, k2] 8 times. 25 sts

**Row 50:** Knit.

**Row 52:** K1, [k2tog, k1] 8 times. 17 sts

**Rows 53-60:** Knit.

Cast off.

### Ears

#### Make 2, starting at the base

With MC, cast on 9 sts.

**Row 1 & foll WS rows:** Purl.

**Row 2:** K3, kfb, k1, kfb, k3.  
11 sts

**Row 4:** Knit.

**Row 6:** K4, kfb, k1, kfb, k4.  
13 sts

**Row 8:** Knit.

**Row 10:** K5, kfb, k1, kfb, k5. 15 sts

**Row 12:** Knit.

**Row 14:** [K1, ssk, k2, k2tog] twice, k1. 11 sts

**Row 16:** [K1, ssk, k2tog] twice, k1. 7 sts

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

### Muzzle

With MC, cast on 28 sts in MC.

**Rows 1-5:** Starting with a p row, work 5 rows in St st.

**Row 6 (RS):** [K5, kfb, k2, kfb, k5] twice. 32 sts

**Row 7 & foll WS rows:** Purl.

**Row 8:** Knit.

**Row 10:** [K5, kfb, k4, kfb, k5] twice. 36 sts

**Rows 11-19:** Work 9 rows in St st.

**Row 20:** K1, [k2tog, k3] 7 times. 29 sts

**Row 22:** K1, [k2tog, k2] 7 times. 22 sts

**Row 24:** K1, [k2tog, k1] 7 times. 15 sts

**Row 26:** K1, [k2tog] 7 times. 8 sts

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

### Head

With CC1, cast on 28 sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** Knit.

**Row 2:** K1, [kfb, k2] 9 times. 37 sts

**Row 3:** Knit.

**Row 4:** K1, [kfb, k8] 4 times. 41 sts



**Rows 5-8:** Knit.

**Row 9:** K1, [k2tog, k3] 8 times. 33 sts

**Row 10:** Knit.

**Row 11:** K1, [k2tog, k2] 8 times. 25 sts

**Row 12:** Knit.

**Row 13:** K1, [k2tog, k1] 8 times. 17 sts

**Row 14:** Knit.

**Row 15:** K1, [k2tog] 8 times. 9 sts

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

## Arms & Legs

**Make 4, starting at top edge**

With MC, cast on 12 sts.

**Rows 1-35:** Starting with a p row, work in St st.

**Row 36 (RS):** K1, kfb, [kfb, k1] 5 times. 18 sts

**Row 37:** Purl.

**Row 38:** K1, kfb, k1, [kfb, k2] 5 times. 24 sts

**Rows 39-43:** Work 5 rows in St st.

**Rows 44-45:** Purl.

**Row 46:** K1, k2tog, [k2tog, k1] 7 times. 16 sts

**Row 47:** Purl.

**Row 48:** [K2tog] 8 times. 8 sts

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

## Tail

With CC1, cast on 14 sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** Knit.

**Row 2:** [K1, kfb, k3, kfb, k1] twice. 18 sts



**Rows 3-5:** Knit.

**Row 6:** [K1, kfb, k5, kfb, k1] twice. 22 sts

**Rows 7-9:** Knit.

**Row 10:** [K1, kfb, k7, kfb, k1] twice. 26 sts

**Rows 11-25:** Knit.

**Row 26:** K1, [k2tog] 12 times, k1. 14 sts

**Rows 27-29:** Knit.

**Row 30:** [K2tog] 7 times. 7 sts



## Amanda's tip...

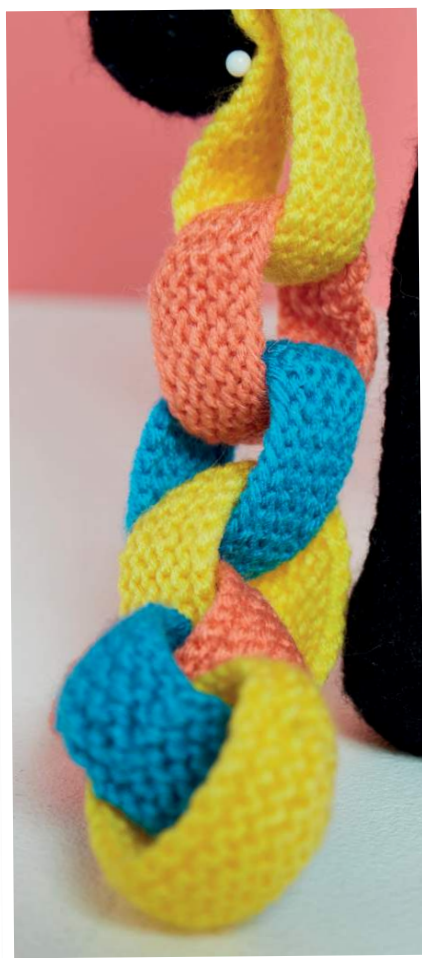
Make up the four arms and legs at the same time so you can check they are all evenly stuffed before sewing onto the body. Use any leftover yarn to knit more paper chains

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

### Scarf

**Note:** Break colours when changing for each section. With CC3, cast on 12 sts.

**Rows 1-11:** Starting with a p row, work 11 rows in St st.



**Rows 12-19:** With MC, work 8 rows in St st.

**Rows 20-31:** With CC2, work 12 rows in St st.

**Rows 32-91:** Rep rows 12-31 three more times.

**Rows 92-99:** With MC, work 8 rows in St st.

**Rows 100-106:** With CC1, work 7 rows in St st.

**Rows 107-114:** With MC, work 8 rows in St st.

**Rows 115-126:** With CC2, work 12 rows in St st.

**Rows 127-186:** Rep rows 107-126 three more times.

**Rows 187-194:** With MC, work 8 rows in St st.

**Rows 195-205:** With CC3, work 11 rows in St st. Cast off.

### Paper Chains

**Make 3 in CC4, 2 in CC3 & 2 in CC2**

Cast on 28 sts.

**Rows 1-9:** Knit. Cast off.

### Hat

With CC2, cast on 38 sts.

**Rows 1-3:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rows 4-11:** Starting with a k row, work 8 rows in St st.

**Row 12 (RS):** K2, [k2tog, k2] 9 times. 29 sts

**Row 13:** Purl.

**Row 14:** K2, [k2tog, k1] 9 times. 20 sts

**Row 15:** Purl.

**Row 16:** [K2tog] 10 times. 10 sts

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

### Making up:

**Head:** Sew tog the cast-on edges of Head and Muzzle. Insert safety eyes at top of Muzzle, and use CC1 to embroider a circle in chain stitch around each eye. Sew the side edges of the Head/Muzzle tog, adding stuffing as you go. With MC, embroider the nostrils in chain stitch circles.

**Ears:** Sew the side edges tog, and sew the cast-on edge onto the top sides of the Head with the seamed edge facing upwards.

**Body:** Sew the side edges tog for the centre back seam. Add some stuffing and gather the cast-on sts tog at the base. Sew the underside of Muzzle onto cast-off edge of Body.

**Arms/Legs:** Sew the side edges together, adding stuffing as you go. Sew the cast-on edge of each Arm/Leg onto Body.

**Tail:** Sew the side edges tog, add stuffing, and sew the cast-on edge onto back of Body.

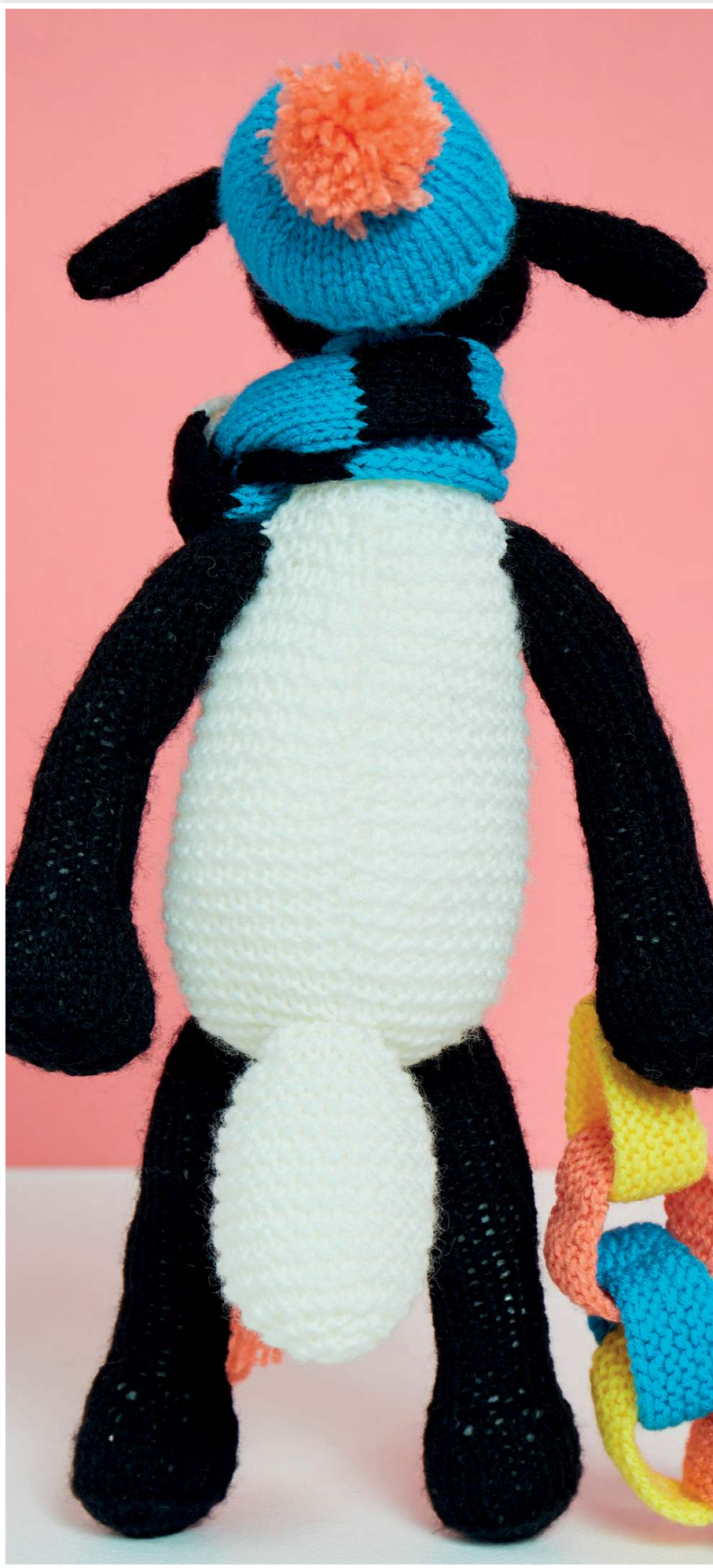
**Scarf:** With a crochet hook and CC3, add tassels at the cast-on and cast-off ends.



With CC1, embroider a snowman shape on the scarf using chain stitch, and with CC3 embroider the snowman's scarf. With MC, embroider the snowman's eyes.

**Hat:** Sew the side edges tog for the back seam. With CC3, make a 3cm diameter pompom and attach to the top of Hat.

**Paper Chain:** Sew the side edges of each piece tog, alternating colours and looping through the previous chain piece each time before joining seam to make a length of chain. Weave in any rem ends.

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## Abbreviations

<b>1x1 rib</b>	k1, p1 ribbing	<b>k2tog</b>	Knit two together	<b>rm</b>	Remove marker
<b>2x2 rib</b>	k2, p2 ribbing	<b>LH</b>	Left hand	<b>rnd</b>	Round
<b>alt</b>	Alternate	<b>m1</b>	Make one by lifting the bar between stitches onto LH needle and knitting into it	<b>Row</b>	Row
