Bedtime snuggly

This simple pattern is easy to knit in chunky yarn – it's the perfect pattern for teaching your little ones to knit

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Need to know...

Yarn used

King Cole Funny Yummy
3 balls in white 4140 (MC)
King Cole Big Value
Super Chunky
3 balls in black 8 (CC1) & 1 ball
in white 1758 (CC2)

About the yarn

MC: Super-chunky; 44m per
100g ball; 100% polyester

CC: Super-chunky; 81m per
100g ball; 100% acrylic

Tension

12 (13) sts x 10 (14) rows =
10cm measured over St st in
MC (CC) on larger needles

Needles used

8mm straight
10mm straight

Other supplies

polyester stuffing
large-eyed darning needle

Sizing

One size, 102cm tall

The pieces of this big snuggly
sheep are all easy to knit. All of
the body and most of the legs
and tail are knitted straight in
stocking stitch, so they would
be ideal pieces for a child to
knit. There is simple shaping
in the feet, tail and ears. The
shaping in the head pieces
take a little more concentration,
so you may want to knit these
bits yourself.

Start knitting...

Body

With MC and larger needles,
cast on 40 sts.
Work in St st until piece
measures 40cm.
Cast off.

Head Front

With CC1 and larger needles,
cast on 6 sts.

Row 1 & all WS rows: Purl.

Row 2: [Kfb] 6 times. 12 sts

Row 4: [Kfb, k1] 6 times. 18 sts

Row 6: Kfb, k1, kfb, k12, kfb,
k1, kfb. 22 sts

Row 8: Kfb, k1, kfb, k16, kfb,
k1, kfb. 26 sts

**Rows 10, 12, 14, 16, 18
& 20:** Knit.

Row 22: K1, ssk, k20, k2tog,
k1. 24 sts

Row 24: Knit.

Row 26: K1, ssk, k18, k2tog,
k1. 22 sts

Row 28: Knit.

Row 30: K1, ssk, k16, k2tog,
k1. 20 sts

Row 32: Knit.

Row 33: Purl.

Cast off.

Head Back

With CC1 and larger needles,
cast on 6 sts

Row 1 & all WS rows: Purl.

Row 2: [Kfb] 6 times. 12 sts

Row 4: [Kfb, k1] 6 times. 18 sts

Row 6: K1, kfb, k14, kfb, k1.
20 sts

Rows 7-31: Work in St st
Cast off.

Head Top

With MC and larger needles,
cast on 36 sts.

Beg with a knit row, work 4 rows
in St st.

Row 5: *K2, k2tog; rep from *
to end. 27 sts

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: *K1 k2tog; rep from *
to end. 18 sts

Cast off

Eyes

Make 2 the same

With CC2 and smaller needles,
cast on 6 sts.

Row 1: [Kfb] 6 times. 12 sts

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: [Kfb, k1] 6 times. 18 sts

Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: [K2tog k1] 6 times.
12 sts

Change to CC2.

Row 8: Purl.

Row 9: [K2tog] 6 times. 6 sts

Stuff eye lightly.

Break yarn, thread through rem
sts and pull tight to fasten.

Legs/Arms

Make 4 the same

With CC1 and larger needles,
cast on 12 sts.

Beg with a purl row, work 35
rows in St st, finishing after a
WS row.

Row 36: [K2, kfb] 4 times.

16 sts

Row 37 & all WS rows: Purl.

Row 38: [K3, kfb] 4 times.

20 sts

Row 40: [K4, kfb] 4 times.

24 sts

Row 42: Knit

Row 44: [K2tog] 12 times.

12 sts

Row 46: [K2tog] 6 times. 6 sts

Break yarn, thread through rem
sts and pull tight to fasten.

Ears

Make 2 the same

With CC1 and larger needles,
cast on 6 sts.

Row 1 & all WS rows: Purl.

Row 2: K1, kfb, k2, kfb, k1.

8 sts

Row 4: Knit.

Row 6: K1, kfb, k4, kfb, k1.

10 sts

Row 8: Knit.



Row 10: K1, kfb, k6, kfb, k1.
12 sts

Rows 12 & 14: Knit.

Row 16: K1, ssk, k6, k2tog, k1.
10 sts

Row 18: K1, ssk, k4, k2tog, k1.
8 sts

Row 20: K1, ssk, k2, k2tog, k1.
6 sts

Row 22: K1, ssk, k2tog, k1.
4 sts

Row 23: [P2tog] twice. 2 sts
Break yarn, thread through rem
sts and pull tight to fasten.

Tail

With MC and larger needles,
cast on 18 sts.

Row 1 & all WS rows: Purl.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 4: K4, kfb, kfb, k6, kfb,
kfb, k4. 22 sts

Row 6: Knit.

Row 8: K5, kfb, kfb, k8, kfb,
kfb, k5. 26 sts

Rows 9-23: Work in St st.
Cast off.

Making up: Sew Head Front
to Head Back along side and
bottom edges, leaving top open
and stuff. Sew back seam of
Head Top and stuff. Attach
to top of head. Sew eyes in
place. Fold body piece in half
lengthways, with purl side
facing out. Sew all seams,
stuffing lightly. Seam and stuff
the tail in the same way. Sew
foot seams and stuff feet
before sewing leg seams. Do
not stuff legs. Sew Legs, Tail
and Head to Body, using photo
as a guide. 🧶

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Abbreviations

1x1 rib	k1, p1 ribbing	k2tog	Knit two together	rm	Remove marker
2x2 rib	k2, p2 ribbing	LH	Left hand	rnd	Round
alt	Alternate	m1	Make one by lifting the bar between stitches onto LH needle and knitting into it	Row	Row
beg	Beginning	mb	Make bobble	RS	Right side
CC	Contrast colour	MC	Main colour	sk2p	Slip 1, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over
ddd	Centred double decrease – slip 2 stitches knitwise together, knit 1, pass slipped stitches over	m1l	Insert the LH needle from front to back under the strand of yarn between the st just worked and the next st on the LH needle.
