Christmas jumpers/tops can be worn with normal uniform on Wednesday 20th December for our Christmas Dinner Day.

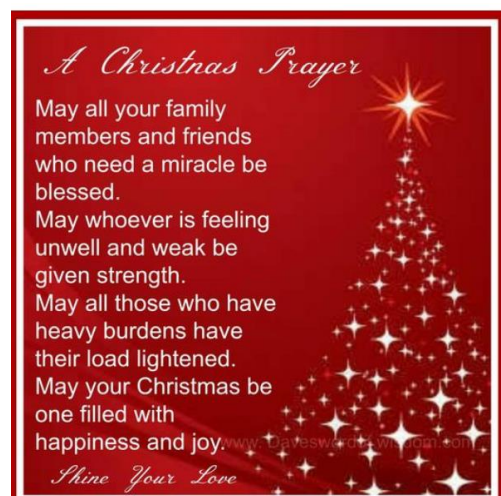
Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 can also wear them for the carol service on Tuesday December 19th.
