Lent begins on the 14th February 2024 and ends on Thursday 28th March 2024. Lent is the period of six weeks (40 days not including Sundays) leading up to Easter. We have lots of activities planned in school and for home.

Lent Bags

After half term the children will have the opportunity to bring home a Lenten bag to share with the family.

'Lent through a Lens' Competition

We are holding a competition for the children called 'Lent through a Lens'. We would like children to take a photo of something that reminds them of Lent. This could be something they have seen in church, when they are out playing or in a museum for example. They can then send this picture into school, either printed, emailed or through class dojo. We will then collect the photos in and send them onto the Missio charity, where they will be entered into a prize draw with other children from around the country. We will also showcase all of the photos on our school website and social media.



The Big Lent Walk

Every Thursday throughout Lent the children will be taking part in 'The Big Lent Walk' for Cafod. This involves walking a total of 5 miles. Each Thursday we will complete 1,300 meters. We are hoping to raise a total of £500 for Cafod to help fight global poverty. Any money raised can make a huge difference to people's lives.

- £10 can provide four palm trees to protect land from extreme weather caused by the climate crisis.
- £26 can provide tools and training to build raised beds to protect vegetables from floods.
- £185 can provide a place on a two-week course: growing food, adapting to extreme weather and new ways of earning a living.
