# School uniform

Thank you for providing your child with the correct school uniform. We review the uniform policy regularly to make sure that it is suitable for families. Recently, we changed the policy to allow children to wear black trainers, this change has been successful and will remain part of the uniform, but I must remind you that the trainers must be full black- including the soles.

We have identified that the PE uniform is not always adhered to on PE days. The hoodies look really smart, but these are only to worn on PE days. From September, the white PE t-shirt will no longer be part of the PE uniform; it is difficult to keep the white t-shirts clean and it is an added expense for you all. We would like the children to wear their normal blue collared t-shirts on PE days. Although this change will be implemented fully in September, we will transition to this through the summer term (after the Easter holidays) and your child can wear either a white or blue t-shirt for PE during this time.

Hopefully the weather will change after the Easter holidays; your children are welcome to wear blue/white summer dresses or shorts. Please continue to send a coat in just incase the weather changes quickly.

# Packed lunches

### Easter Egg decoration

### Water bottles

We have made the decision to stop providing the children with school water bottles. Many of you do use our water bottles, but many children bring in a non-school bottle and it is becoming too difficult to monitor this. We have limited stock of school water bottles left in the office; if you would like one then please pay cash to the office. The water bottle option will be removed from ParentPay.

Please provide your child with a fresh water bottle each day. The bottles must be no larger than 1 litre and must be able to be sealed or allow the straw to be tucked in and your child must be open to open them independently. The new style 'Stanley' cups are not allowed as they easily spill. Please make sure that your child can recognise their own bottle and add a name on if possible. We will not accept responsibility for any bottles that are lost or damaged, so please do not send expensive bottles to school.

### Red Nose Day

We raised an incredible £366.50 last Friday. As previously shared, half of this will go to Red Nose Day and half of it will go to our school fund and will be spent directly on the children.

#### Play equipment
