We are looking appoint an exceptional HLTA. The successful candidate will have extensive knowledge of the primary curriculum.

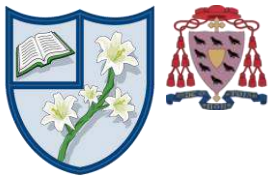
We are looking for someone who:
